

Sunset Creek Swimming Pool Rules

1. The pool will be open at dawn, and close at dusk (15 minutes after sunset) during the swim season.
2. Evacuating the pool and deck area during electrical storms is mandatory (the pool will be closed for 30 minutes in the event of thunder, and 60 minutes in the event of visible lightening).
3. No lifeguard is on duty. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk.
4. Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult (age 18 or older) at ALL times. Unaccompanied homeowner children ages 14 and up may have 2 guests of the same age range. More than 2 guests requires the presence of an adult homeowner. Unsupervised children under the age 14 are not allowed in the pool or pool area. Children under age 4 must have an adult with them in the pool at all times.
5. Adults should not swim alone.
6. Homeowners are allowed a maximum of 6 guests per household and must accompany their guests at the pool at all times. If a homeowner has more than 6 guests, this is considered a pool party, and must be scheduled with the pool/clubhouse scheduler.
7. All pool parties must be scheduled with the pool/clubhouse scheduler even if the Clubhouse is not going to be used. A refundable \$150 deposit and a non-refundable \$30 rental fee are due when the reservation is made. For pool parties there is a maximum of 12 guests per party. The homeowner must be present at all times. (See, Sunset Creek Clubhouse Rules.)
8. Only 1 party will be scheduled at any time.
9. The following are not allowed in the pool area: glass containers, gum, bikes, roller blades, skates, skateboards, or any similar type item.
10. No running, boisterous, or rough play.
11. No diving is allowed.
12. No person with skin, eye, ear or nasal infections is allowed in the pool.
13. No person is allowed in the pool if ill with diarrhea within the last two weeks.
14. No person with a communicable disease is allowed in the pool.
15. All patrons MUST shower before entering the pool.
16. No animals or pets are allowed in the pool, on the deck, or inside the fenced pool area.
17. No eating or drinking in the pool water or at the pool edge. Food and drink is allowed in the pool area away from these areas. Please clean up after yourself.
18. No alcohol is allowed on the pool premises. No person under the influence of alcohol or drugs should use the pool.
19. No glass is allowed in the pool, on the deck, or inside the fenced pool area. Beverages should be in re-sealable containers.
20. Smoking is not permitted in the pool area, restrooms, or clubhouse.
21. Infants in diapers or other individuals that may be incontinent MUST use approved swimming diapers. Regular diapers may not be worn, with or without rubber pants.
22. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk. Owners and management are not responsible for accidents or injuries.
23. No one is to sit, stand, or swim over safety lines or lane ropes.
24. The pool is for private use. Homeowners and guests only.
25. Management reserves the right to deny use of the pool to anyone at any time.
26. Management reserves the right to inspect all coolers and/or bags.
